



IMA 301 Sound Stage Painting Protocols

- Students are responsible for purchasing paint and peripheral items (rollers, trays, brushes etc) if altering the standard paint colour of any Sound Stage flats, doors etc.
- Water based latex paints only can be used. No oil or alkyd paint.
- Prior to painting, use the supplied canvas tarps to lay on the floor under the items to be painted, with sufficient coverage around the edges.
- Place all peripheral items on plastic or tarp as well.
- Any paint on the floor must be cleaned up immediately.
- All peripheral items must be cleaned up with water in the IMA 305 paint room. The sink, floor, table must be left clean and free of any paint residue.
- Remove all items from the paint room after use.
- All sound stage flats must be faired and re-painted to the original colour, **(Grey Heron # OR-114 Benjamin Moore, Flat Latex)** following use. You can use any brand name but must be the BJ colour.
- Painter tape only is to be used for position marks and must be removed once complete (NO DUCT TAPE ON THE FLOOR).
- Any wallpaper used on flats must be removed and the flats repainted.
- All flats are to be returned to the flat cart

Fines will be levied if protocols not followed.
